## Seventy-Two Named To GNAC Soccer Academic Team

SPOKANE, Wash. - A total of 72 student-athletes – 43 women and 29 men - have been named to the 2011 Great Northwest Athletic Conference Soccer Academic all-star team.

Heading up the women's academic team is sophomore Jenny Field of Northwest Nazarene who has a 3.99 grade point average. She is a biology major from Beaverton, Ore.

Montana State Billings placed 10 women on the academic team. Seattle Pacific earned eight spots and Northwest Nazarene had six players selected to the team. Saint Martin's and Western Oregon had five each.

NNU's Stephen Marshall, a junior pre-physical therapy major from Palm Springs, Calif., has the top GPA (3.97) on the men's academic team. Seattle Pacific placed the most student-athletes on the men's team with nine. MSUB and NNU each had five student-athletes selected, while Saint Martin's had four.

Seven student-athletes were named to the soccer academic team for the third time, including four women – Hilary Franks of Central Washington, Jessie Cahill of Northwest Nazarene and Kelsey Jenkins and Janie Wurth of Seattle Pacific and three men – James Schmid of Saint Martin's, Matt Larsen of Northwest Nazarene and Drew Williams of SPU.

An additional 24 student-athletes, 15 women and nine men - earned academic all-star honors for the second time.

To be eligible for the GNAC academic team, student-athletes must be a letter winner, have a minimum grade point average of 3.20 and be in at least their second year of competition at their university.
